Subject: Request for dissemination of Financial Assistance for Education Scheme among private schools in Delhi for the benefit of children of registered construction workers.

Sir/Madam,

1. The Delhi Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board (DBOCWW Board), constituted under the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996, is implementing various welfare schemes for the social and educational upliftment of registered construction workers and their dependents.

2. One of the major welfare measures of the Board is the scheme of Financial Assistance for Education under Rule 281 of the Delhi Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 2002. Under this provision, educational assistance is provided to the children of live registered construction workers studying from Class 1st to 12th.

3. The rate of financial assistance is as under:-

Class 1st to 8th - Rs. 500/- per month
Class 9th to 10th - Rs. 700/- per month
Class 11th to 12th - Rs. 1000/- per month

4. Further, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the matter titled "Delhi State Nirman and Building Kamgar Union & Anr. Vs. Delhi Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board & Anr." vide order dated 27.11.2024 approved a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) and timeline for verification and disbursement of educational assistance to eligible beneficiaries. The Hon'ble Court has also emphasized that welfare benefits under Rule 281 should be made accessible to all eligible children of registered construction workers studying in schools across Delhi.

5. In this regard, it is submitted that many children of registered construction workers are presently enrolled in recognized private schools under the Directorate of Education, GNCTD. However, due to lack of awareness and outreach, several eligible students are not availing the benefits of the scheme.

6. Since the Directorate of Education has an important role in strengthening educational access and student welfare in schools, it is requested that necessary directions may kindly be issued to all recognized private schools in Delhi to create awareness regarding the said scheme and encourage eligible students to apply for financial assistance through the DBOCWW Board.

7. The schools may also be requested to extend cooperation in certification/verification of student-related documents required for processing of applications.

8. The eligible construction workers may submit applications directly in the concerned district offices of the DBOCWW Board along with the following documents:-

1. Prescribed application form (Annexure 'A')
2. Valid Registration Certificate/Passbook of the registered worker;
3. Attendance Certificate duly certified by the Head of School (minimum 50% attendance);
4. School Identity Card of the student;
5. Copy of marksheet of previous class;
6. Aadhaar details;
7. Bank account details for Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT).
8. 01 witness along with his /her Aadhar card.
9. Any other document as deemed fit in support of the genuinity of construction worker.

9. The Board shall provide all required assistance and facilitation to eligible beneficiaries for smooth implementation of the scheme.


